Principal Investigator & Director - Florida's School Climate Transformation (Florida SCT) Grant. Funded by the U.S. Department of Education's Office of Elementary and Secondary Education (OESE) through the Florida Department of Education to significantly expand Florida's state-wide system of behavioral support. Provides training and technical assistance to local education agencies (LEAs) in implementing an evidence-based, multi-tiered behavior framework for improving behavioral outcomes and learning conditions for all students. Total USF budget = \$3,365,904 (2014-2019).

Co-Principal Investigator, Co-Director - Florida's Positive Behavior Interventions and Support: Multi-Tiered System of Support Project (FLPBIS:MTSS). The *FLPBIS:MTSS Project* is funded by the Florida Department of Education, Bureau of Exceptional Student Services to build the capacity of school districts to apply positive, research-validated approaches to resolve significant behavior problems at the individual student, classroom, and/or school-wide levels. Training and technical assistance using a multi-tiered system of supports are provided state-wide to districts, schools, classrooms, and individual utilizing a problem-solving process to ensure the highest possible student performance in behavior in order to enhance academic success. Almost 2,000 schools across 80% of Florida's school districts have been trained and are actively implementing PBIS. Of those schools trained, over 78% are implementing PBIS with high fidelity. Since 2006; Annual USF budget = \$1,735,000 (2016-2017 and 2017-2018).

Co-Principal Investigator, Co-Director, Research Partner & Resource Agent - Center for Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports (PBIS). The *TA Center on PBIS* is a five-year (received 4 cycles of 5-year funding to

date) United States Department of Education, Office of Special Education Programs technical assistance grant awarded to the Universities of Oregon, Connecticut and Missouri to build capacity to implement school-wide positive behavior support at local, district and state-wide levels (to over 23,000 schools nationally) collaboratively with faculty from multiple universities across the country. Activities include training, technical assistance, product development, evaluation, dissemination activities, and coordinating a Model Demonstration Project with 5 Florida schools examining the efficacy of Tiers 2 & 3 interventions within an existing SWPBS school. (Since 2003; Annual USF budget = \$450,000). Ongoing technical assistance as a result of the federal grant is provided to the following: *Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Louisiana, Texas, Mississippi, and Puerto Rico.*

Co-Principal Investigator & Co-Director – Preparing Tiered System Behavior Analysts (TSBA). *Project TSBA* is a five-year United States Department of Education, Office of Special Education Programs personnel preparation grant to address state-identified needs to improve the quality and increase the number of personnel locally who are fully credentialed to serve children with disabilities and behavioral challenges. This Personnel Preparation grant builds on the strengths of the current Master’s program in Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) at USF to prepare 17 students to graduate with a Master’s degree in ABA, obtain certification as a Board Certified Assistant Behavior Analysts (BCBA), conduct 500 hours of school-based practicum, and to receive the Positive Behavior Support Certificate. Total USF budget = \$999,000 (2011-2016).

Director - Research and Demonstration Center for School-wide Behavior Support. Funded by the United States Department of Education, Office of Special Education Programs (OSEP) as a Model Demonstration Grant. Awarded to the University of Oregon to conduct research and technical assistance activities. Nine Florida elementary schools served as demonstration sites for school-wide positive behavior support.
